I am a resident of [your constituency] and I am writing to express my deep concern about human trafficking and modern slavery in the UK. In 2024, the National Referral Mechanism identified 19,125 potential victims, with British citizens being the most trafficked nationality. Alarming, 3 in 10 of referrals were children.

As a supporter of the UK charity *Their Voice*, which helps survivors of modern slavery, I am acutely aware of the urgent need for stronger measures to combat this crime and support victims. *Their Voice* and similar organisations are essential in raising awareness and empowering survivors, yet more must be done.

I would like to ask for your views on the following:

1. What is your stance on the current state of human trafficking and modern slavery in the UK?
2. What actions or policies do you believe the government should prioritise to combat human trafficking and modern slavery more effectively?
3. Are there any initiatives you are personally involved in or supporting that are aimed at tackling these issues?

I firmly believe that, as a nation, we must continue to fight against the exploitation of vulnerable individuals and ensure that survivors receive the support they need to rebuild their lives. I would be grateful for your response and insights on these important matters.
